#### Context

Scottish Government commissioned the SSSC to provide recommendations on the design, implementation and delivery of a sustainable and accessible national approach to a supported year for NQSWs.

This will be owned and implemented by the sector as part of advanced practice framework activities.



#### Purpose

To ensure that all newly qualified social workers have access to, engage with and reflect on a range of professional learning and development opportunities to evidence consolidation, development and advancement of their social work skills, knowledge, and values.

# Key Messages

- Programme of work ongoing since 2018 and informed by the sector.
- Part of a response to create a strategic framework from qualifying education through to advanced practice.
- Best practice model building on employer responsibilities and good practice across the country.
- Will set a consistent standard for newly qualified social workers professional development.
- Scottish Government have indicated that there will be mandatory implementation across Scotland in September 2024
- 10 areas are currently implementing the approach
- Recognise there are operational challenges and resource implications.
- Required to protect social work professional identity.
- Social Work Education Partnership is likely to have oversight of implementation.









#### Evidencing progress during the NQSW Supported Year









The Scottish Government has allocated £350,000 to support a small-scale early implementation of the NQSW Supported Year.

#### Implementation grant overview

- One time funding for implementation capacity building.
- Reflect local arrangements.
- Funding length: 12 months.
- Sustainable beyond grant period.
- Applications are welcomed from single employers or those working in partnership.
- Threshold of £50,000 per organisation or for organisations working in partnership.
- Must align to NQSW core elements






### Who can apply?

The fund is open to:

- employers who intend to recruit NQSWs into their workforce in the next 12 months
- single employers or partnership arrangements, for third and independent sectors applications we would expect these to be submitted as part of a partnership with a local authority being the lead.
- The 10 implementation areas currently involved are not eligible for this funding



## The application criteria

- A clear rationale and plan for what you propose to do to support implementation and embed the core elements of the NQSW Supported Year.
- How you plan to measure the impact of the proposed changes.
- How you plan to sustain the changes over time.
- Costings including amount applied for and the employer's contribution.
   In kind support can be considered.
