### <u>Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) issued under COVID-19 emergency health regulations by</u> police forces in England and Wales

#### Introduction

This release presents the latest data on the police use of COVID-19 enforcement notices issued under all emergency health protection regulations in force as at 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021<sup>1</sup> (and includes revisions to previously published figures).

Data on FPNs issued in England and Wales is collated centrally by the ACRO Criminal Records Office and cover the 43 territorial forces, the British Transport Police (BTP) and Ministry of Defence Police.

The figures below relate to enforcement activity by police forces and these data should be seen in the context of wider police activity to engage with the public to explain and encourage compliance with the new regulations. As outlined in previous releases, the police have recorded hundreds of thousands of Covid-19 related incidents since 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020. This will include incidents where officers have proactively offered advice to people, responded to reports from members of the public about breaches of the regulations by others, and offences where criminals have sought to take advantage of the pandemic to commit crime.

### <u>Headline figures for FPNs issued under the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions)</u> <u>Regulations, England and Wales</u>

In total, 118,963<sup>2</sup> notices have been recorded as having been issued in England (106,907<sup>3</sup>) and Wales (12,056) between Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021. Almost all these notices were issued up to 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021, after which all restrictions were lifted in England (not including the International Travel Regulations). Whilst most restrictions in Wales were revoked after the 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021, requirements to wear a face covering were still in place (under number five regulations), furthermore some restrictions were reinstated during the Winter period to help curb the spread of the Omicron variant. International Travel Regulations (ITR) continue to be in place in England and Wales; notices issued under the ITR for Wales are presented in this section and those issued in England are presented separately in the sections below along with notices issued under the face covering regulations (England).

In England, up to 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021:

- 15,947 notices were issued under number one regulations;
- 583 under number two regulations;
- 374 for holding a gathering of more than 30 people;
- 1,115 in relation to breaches of local "lockdowns";
- 2,925 under the "Local COVID-19 alert levels";

- 7,168 under number four regulations (national restrictions);
- 73,778 notices issued under the "All Tiers" regulations:
  - 19 notices for Tier 1 (Medium);
  - 1,073 notices for Tier 2 (High);
  - 3,779 notices for Tier 3 (Very High);
  - 68,907 notices for Tier 4 (Extremely High); 65,053 of which were issued from 6<sup>th</sup> January 2021 when national restrictions came into force.
- 5,017 were issued under the steps regulations:
  - 2,436 notices for Step 1
  - 2,343 notices for Step 2
  - 238 notices for Step 3

In Wales, up to 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021:

- 2,665 notices were issued under number one regulations;
- 176 notices were issued under number two regulations;
- 283 notices were issued under number three regulations;
- 662 notices were issued under number four regulations;
- 8,235 notices have been issued under number five regulations;
- 3 notices were issued under regulations relating to holding a gathering of more than 30 people; and,
- 32 notices were issued under the International Travel Regulations (ITRs).

Chart 1 shows previously published figures for earlier reporting periods together with the latest revisions as more FPNs have been processed. In earlier releases this was reported on a daily basis but, given the length of time these regulations have been in place, this is now summarised on a weekly basis. The following analysis and the chart below do not include fines issued under the face covering regulations, business regulations, or ITRs issued in England. Separate analysis is presented in the sections below for these FPN types.

Enforcement levels have been falling since the peak in early February 2021. English police forces have not issued an FPN since 18th July 2021, when the government announced the move to Step 4 and lifting of most restrictions on 19th July 2021. Forces in Wales have continued to issue a small number of FPNs since the easing of COVID restrictions in Wales on 7th August. Police in Wales have issued 34 FPNs since 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021, 13 of which have been issued since 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021 when these figures were last published.

Following the announcement in March 2021 of the roadmap out of lockdown, there was a steep downward trend in the number of FPNs issued. This continued through to September 2021 with figures showing an average of 13 FPNs having been issued each week in July  $(2^{nd} - 29^{th} July 2021)$  compared with an average of 3 FPNs weekly in August and September (30<sup>th</sup> July -23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021) and the majority of these having been issued in Wales.

Looking at the longer-term trend, there were steep rises in the number of FPNs issued following the week of 18<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> December 2020, coinciding with the introduction of Tier 4 as part of the "Local COVID-19 Alert Levels" regulations. This upward trend continued following the introduction of the new national restrictions on the 6<sup>th</sup> of January 2021 (when all areas of England were moved into Tier 4). This reflected more proactive policing of the regulations in the context of the danger to public health and represented a shift to move more quickly to enforcement where there were clear breaches of the law.

Enforcement levels during January and early February 2021 returned to levels seen in March and April 2020, when restrictions were first introduced with a peak of 3,296 FPNs issued between  $10^{th} - 16^{th}$  April 2020 (during the week of the Easter Bank holiday). Enforcement


levels continued to decline from March 2021 to June 2021 as restrictions eased and activity that led to the most common reasons for the issuing of FPNs (gatherings of two or more people) were no-longer prohibited under the current restrictions.

Of all enforcement notices issued in England and Wales:

- The most common reason for which an FPN was issued in England was a "Contravene a requirement to not participate in a gathering in the Tier 4 area of two or more people - private dwelling/any indoor space", with 32,062 FPNS and, similarly, the most common reason in Wales was "Contravene requirement to not participate in a gathering in private" with 3,889 FPNs issued for this reason (Table 1).
- The large majority (7 in 10) of FPNs were issued to males (Table 2).
- 76% were issued to the under 35s; with 48% issued to 18-24-year olds, 16% to those aged 25-29 and 12% to those aged 30-34 (Table 3).
- Of those FPNs where the individual issued with the notice had a self-identified ethnicity<sup>3</sup> recorded, 76% were issued to people who self-identified as White. 12% went to those who self-identified as Asian and 7% to those identifying as Black (Table 4).

### Headline figures for FPNs issued under the face coverings regulations, England and Wales


A total of 626 notices have been recorded as having been issued by police forces under the Wearing of Face Coverings on Public Transport Regulations between 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021, and 3,123 notices have been issued under the Wearing of Face Coverings in a Relevant Place Regulations between 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021. These regulations were revoked in England on 19th July.

Face covering legislation was later re-introduced in England. As of 30th November 2021 the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Wearing of Face Coverings) (England) Regulations 2021 came into effect. As these regulations are still new and notices are being processed, a detailed update on the number of FPNs issued under these regulations will be provided in the next statistical release.

### Face coverings on public transport

No FPNs have been issued under face coverings on public transport regulations since July 2021 after COVID restrictions regarding face coverings were eased on 19<sup>th</sup> July. A weekly count of FPNs issued under face coverings on public transport regulations has shown that in the month of July only 1 FPN was issued (with 626 notices issued between 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021). The number of FPNs issued peaked at 72 FPNs in the first week of February 2021 following the introduction of restrictions in January 2021. As restrictions started to ease, the number of FPNs issued per week dropped, returning to levels seen prior to the tightening of restrictions. There was a small spike in June 2021 when 15 FPNs were issued between 7<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> June 2021, but levels quickly dropped again. In the last full week the restrictions were in place, no FPNs were issued under face coverings on public transport regulations (12<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021).

### Chart 2: FPNs issued under Face coverings on public transport regulations between 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and the last full week ending 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021



Further breakdowns of FPNs issued under the Face coverings on public transport regulations are presented below.

• The vast majority of FPNs issued under this regulation type were issued to males (around 8 in 10).

- Over half (57%) were issued to individuals aged between 18 and 29.
- Of the 471 records where ethnicity was provided, the majority (58%) were issued to individuals who self-identified as White, a lower proportion than other FPNs. This may reflect the use of public transport being more prevalent in metropolitan areas.
- BTP issued most of such FPNs to date (250 out of 626) for individuals not complying with the transport regulations, followed by the Metropolitan Police Service (242).
- Most FPNs issued under these regulations were for contravening the requirement to wear a face covering when on public transport (589 Table 5).



### Face coverings in a relevant place

No FPNs have been issued under face coverings in a relevant place regulations since July 2021 due to COVID restrictions being revoked on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Between 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021, 3,123 FPNs were issued under face coverings in a relevant place regulation. Very few FPNs were issued in the first couple of months that the regulations were in place (July to September). However, at the start of October the number of FPNs increased, with 74 FPNs issued between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020. The number of FPNs issued peaked following the tightening of restrictions in January 2021, with 254 FPNs being issued in the second week of February 2021. Since the easing of restrictions in March 2021 FPNs issued under face coverings in a relevant place regulation was in place (25<sup>th</sup> June – 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021) an average of 2 FPNs were issued a week.

Further breakdowns of FPNs issued under face coverings in a relevant place regulations are presented below.

- The majority of FPNs issued under this regulation type were issued to males (75%).
- 43% of FPNs were issued to individuals aged between 18 and 29.
- Of the 2,608 records where ethnicity was provided, the majority (69%) were issued to individuals who self-identified as White.



### Headline figures for FPNs issued under the International Travel Regulations, England

A total of 829 notices have been recorded as having been issued by police forces under the International Travel regulations between 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021, of which 3 FPNs were issued since the previous update on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

The number of FPNs issued was low in the first few months when the regulations were in place (June to August) but began to increase in September and October 2020. Following the introduction of the second national lockdown in November 2020, FPN numbers decreased rapidly reflecting the reduction in international travel. By December 2020, an average of 11 FPNs were issued per week (30<sup>th</sup> November – 27<sup>th</sup> December 2020). When the January restrictions were introduced in 2021 (which brought in stricter rules around isolating following travel abroad), the number of FPNs issued fluctuated with a peak of 44 FPNs during 1<sup>st</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> March 2021. The number of FPNs issued each week saw a decline from the end of March 2021. During August and September 2021, regulations were relaxed and individuals were no longer required to quarantine if they were fully vaccinated and had a negative COVID test. A small number of FPNs (9) was issued between 16<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2021 which is likely to reflect an increase in international travel over the summer period. In the 6 weeks from 11<sup>th</sup> October to 21<sup>st</sup> November 2021 there were no FPNs issued, reflecting the testing requirements for fully vaccinated individuals being further reduced and the introduction of a shorter single red list of countries. However, in the month from 22<sup>nd</sup> November – 19<sup>th</sup> December 2021 a further 3 FPNs were issued as international travel rules were tightened again to control the spread of the new Omicron variant.

Further breakdowns of FPNs issued under the International Travel regulations (England) are presented below.

- The majority (67%) of FPNs under this regulation were issued to males (Table 7).
- Almost half (48%) were issued to individuals under 35 (Table 8).

- Of the 656 records where ethnicity was provided, the majority (62%) were issued to individuals who self-identified as White; 22% were issued to Asian individuals, and 11% to Black individuals (Table 9).
- The Metropolitan Police Service issued the most FPNs to date (174 out of 829) for individuals not complying with the international travel regulations.
- Most FPNs issued under these regulations were for "Person arrives in England fails to self-isolate" (697 Table 10).

#### Understanding the data

These data cover the number of FPNs issued under COVID-19 regulations which came into effect from 27th March 2020.

Data presented in this release represent the number of FPNs issued. While the vast majority of FPNs relate to a single individual, some people have been issued with an FPN more than once. An FPN can be issued for more than one reason.

Figures on the number of FPNs issued should not be seen as a measure of the amount of police activity involved in policing the new measures, or the level of public non-compliance, since fines are issued as a last resort after initial attempts to engage with the public to explain and encourage compliance with the new regulations have not been successful.

Owing to the time taken to process FPNs, figures presented here are likely to underestimate the volume of FPNs issued each day and will be updated with each release as new data are received, although the rate of increase in revised data has slowed significantly.

The nature of the administrative process involved in issuing an FPN is such that there is sometimes missing data or discrepancies when data are returned. For example, as ethnicity is self-defining this is not always completed, and the level of missing data needs to be considered when interpreting such figures.

Force level figures are presented for England in Annex A and Wales in Annex B. However, caution should be taken when making comparisons between forces as variation in is likely to reflect a range of factors including how the force has decided to police non-compliance as well as differences in local context (e.g. composition and density of the local population).
