### Saturday 23 December

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes. Trains run to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and St Pancras only.
- Additional line closures between Sevenoaks and Tonbridge and Sittingbourne and Sheerness.

### Sunday 24 December

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes. Trains run to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and St Pancras only.
- Additional line closures between Sevenoaks and Tonbridge and Sittingbourne and Sheerness.
- Services will close down earlier than normal, with final departures for most stations to/from London being between 1900 and 2000.
- No trains run after 2200. Check our website for details of last trains.

### Monday 25 December (Christmas Day)

- No services.

### Tuesday 26 December (Boxing Day)

- No services. High speed services are NOT running on Boxing Day this year.

### Wednesday 27 to Friday 29 December

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes with a significantly reduced service to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and Blackfriars.

- Additional high speed services to and from St Pancras – non high speed tickets will be accepted on these three days only.
- Where possible, passengers should avoid travelling during the peak hours (0730 to 0930 and 1700 to 1830). Victoria services are expected to be very busy and your journey into London may be easier if you take a diverted service to Blackfriars, Waterloo or St Pancras or use bus, tube or DLR alternatives. Make sure you have a plan B!

### Saturday 30 December

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes. Trains run to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and St Pancras only.

### Sunday 31 December (New Year's Eve)

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes. Trains run to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and St Pancras only.
- Additional late night and early morning (1 January) trains from Victoria for New Year's Eve revellers. Expect these to be very busy. Check our website for details of last train times.

### Monday 1 January (New Year's Day)

- No Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East, Cannon Street, London Bridge, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, New Cross and St Johns.
- Amended timetable on all Southeastern routes. Trains run to and from Victoria, Waterloo (main line) and St Pancras only.
- Additional line closures between: Hither Green, Sidcup and Dartford; Otford, Maidstone East and Ashford International; Deal, Dover Priory and Folkestone Central; Canterbury East and Dover Priory.
