

Full road closure to Orphanage Road from Monday 2 February – Friday 17 April 2015.

Major work to replace the railway bridge at Orphanage Road in Watford will start in February as essential improvements to provide a better, more reliable railway for passengers on the West Coast main line continues.

In addition, there are major restrictions to train services to and from London Euston from 14-16 and 21-23 February.

Over Easter there will be no West Coast main line service between London Euston and Hemel Hempstead from 3 – 7 April.

Pedestrian access will be limited to Monday 2 February until Monday 23 February from 5:30pm until 7am.
