Dear Rail Passengers,

A national rail strike has been called for **Monday 25th May** and **Tuesday 26th May** that could severely disrupt your journeys.

I know how much you rely on the railway to take you to and from work and to meet friends and family and I know how businesses rely on the railway to move their goods around the country. For these reasons we are working closely with ACAS and the trade unions to try to find the earliest possible resolution.

If this strike goes ahead, many parts of the railway may be closed on **Monday** and **Tuesday** causing disruption to train services. I encourage you to plan ahead and check before you travel.
