Continuous professional learning (CPL) plays a key role in supporting and improving day-to-day practice.

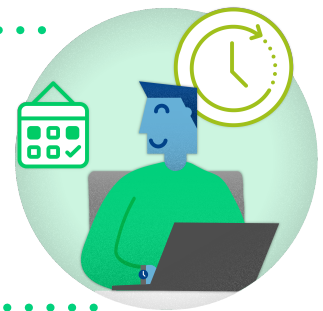

You need to complete a set number of hours of learning during each registration period.

It's not just about formal training courses – it can be every day learning in your workplace, reading, supervision, Open Badges and more.

Record your CPL as you go along in the way that suits you best, like a learning log, your employer's system or the MyLearning app.

When your registration renews, we'll ask you to confirm you've kept a record and completed the required hours.

If we choose to sample your CPL, we may ask you to review your learning with your supervisor.
