We are excited to announce that another cohort of the popular leadership programme, **You as a Collaborative Leader (YaCL)**, will be running again in Autumn 2024.

YaCL is a programme for health and social services professionals working in integration, to develop the skills and knowledge to lead effectively across integrated settings where effective collaboration is essential.

YaCL is an interactive learning programme comprising a mix of self-directed learning, reflective practice, online workshops, smaller online peer thinking groups and 1:1 coaching and will take place over three months between October 2024 - December 2024.

This programme offers opportunities to:

- Reflect on your own leadership style and learn new leadership models & theories
- Improve confidence around influencing effectively in collaborative settings
- Understand how to build better cross sector relationships
- Learn from speakers and peers from integrated health and social care settings
- Engage in reflective practice and peer support

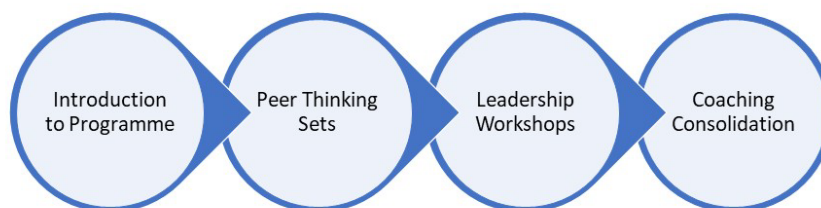
